

ENERGY ISOLATION SPECIALIST Neptune Bulk Terminals (North Vancouver, BC)

Neptune Terminals is a shipping terminal in the Port of Vancouver. Privately owned, we handle Canadian potash and steelmaking coal for export to markets around the world. We place a priority on safe operations and a positive safety culture that ensures everyone who works at or visits our site goes home safely at the end of each day. We have strong environmental systems and performance, and invest in programs to protect and enhance our local environment. We have been operating in North Vancouver for more than 50 years, are very actively engaged in the local community providing support to many non-profit events and organizations, and have positive relationships with our neighbours and local stakeholders.

Neptune has approximately 360 employees, consisting of 50 staff positions and contractors, along with unionized foremen and a workforce drawn from the International Longshore and Warehouse Union (ILWU locals 514 and 500).

Our shareholders are currently investing capital to expand our throughput capacity, which when combined with rail and other infrastructure improvements, is expected to result in growth over the next several years.

This is a new position that will report directly to the Maintenance Manager at Neptune, located at 1001 Low Level Road in North Vancouver.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES WILL INCLUDE:

The Energy Isolation Specialist provides support to contractors and employees working onsite. He/she will play a key role in ensuring all systems are properly isolated using the Lock Out/Tag Out/Test Out Procedure (LOTOTO) when required.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop energy control procedures and help coordinate daily lockout requirements in cooperation with Operations/Maintenance/Projects
- Develop a Permit To Work System for all stages of large scale projects including construction, pre-commissioning, commissioning and operations
- Work with document control to develop a communication procedure for safety alerts, Notice of Energization (NOEs)
- Maintain energy control procedures annually (electrical/hydraulic/pneumatic/gravity)
- Develop and perform the LOTO training program
- Support project managers and contractors in lock box and energy control
- Perform periodic LOTO inspections and audits
- Develop a procedure for Pre-Startup Safety Review (PSSR) to be used prior to project hand over
- Assist with site hazard assessments in determining required LOTO on equipment
- Directly liaise with contractors (long/ short term) to communicate facility safety expectations and work to improve overall contractor safety performance
- Attend various contractor and operations safety meetings
- Participate in investigations, and ensure they are completed and presented in a timely manner
- Coach and mentor contractors on the use of the Safety Management System
- Use ISNetworld, Enablon, incident reporting and follow up tools
- Champion the use of safety program tools including FLRAs, pre-task forms, and risk registers
- Audits contractor performance to ISNet, regulatory and Neptune Bulk Terminals standards

SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Extensive knowledge of electrical trades, isolation procedures, use of drawings and schematics
- Extensive experience managing transition of projects from construction through commissioning to operations
- Track record of support for safety culture
- Strong organizational skills; ability to manage multiple priorities
- Superior verbal and written communication skills
- Experienced in training delivery
- Proficient with MS Office: Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint
- Ability to lead or participate in incident investigations. Experience with ICAM process an asset.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

The successful candidate will have an Electrical certification or degree and a minimum of five years' related experience leading energy isolation. Experience with safety management systems is also essential.
